

MOE Financial Assistance Scheme

1. From January 2026, the income eligibility criteria for the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) have been revised as follows:
 - a) Gross monthly household income (GHI) of \$4,000 and below; or
 - b) Gross monthly household per capita income (PCI) of \$1,000 and below.

Revised benefits for the MOE FAS for Singapore citizen students are summarised below:
