The International and Strategic Affairs Council (ISAC) is part of the school's Talent Development Programme for students interested in Model United Nations (MUN) and current affairs. ISAC seeks to nurture leaders who are passionate about pertinent societal issues, and possess the will to make a positive difference to society. It also seeks to inculcate an interest in diplomacy, active citizenry and leadership among Dunmanians.

Our training sessions nurture sensitivity to pertinent global issues, oratorical skills and critical thinking. ISACers actively participate in Model United Nations conferences such as the Model United Nations Preparatory Conference and the Singapore Model Cabinet. At these conferences, ISACers represent countries as delegates in simulated sessions of United Nations bodies to debate about a variety of topics.

Additionally, ISACers have represented Dunman High School at a variety of current affairs competitions such as the biennial Singapore ASEAN Quiz and the National University of Singapore Political Association Chancellors' Challenge Shield.

Beyond developing academic knowledge and oratorical skills, ISACers will hone their organisational skills in the planning of our flagship MUN conference, the Dunman High Model ASEAN Plus Summit (DHAP), which attracts participants from the region.
